New Business

1. Update on Trash Cans Installation Along Aliso Viejo Parkway

Discussion: AVCA reported purchase of two trash cans for installation on Aliso Viejo Parkway. Due to a delay with the supplier, delivery is anticipated on July 10. AVCA is discussing the possibility of ordering additional trash cans.

Action: None

2. AVCA and City Roles in Aliso Viejo Town Center and The Commons Mixed-Use Project Approvals

Discussion: City requested clarification regarding AVCA's role in approving mixed-use projects. AVCA legal counsel is reviewing and drafting HOA assessment and voting procedures for AVCA Board of Directors approval.

Action: Both agencies to continue discussions with own legal counsel.

3. Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD) Presence at AVCA July 4th Fireworks Event

Discussion: AVCA requested cost estimate for public safety presence at July 4th event. AVCA anticipates 5,000-6,000 attendees, with the event spanning from 5-10 p.m. AVCA no longer requires public safety presence at smaller events.

Action: OCSD will evaluate event details and provide AVCA with a quote.

4. Status of 89 Playa Foreclosure for Failure to Pay AVCA Dues

Discussion: City reported the tenant at 89 Playa failed to provide proof of income eligibility and defaulted on AVCA dues.

Action: City and AVCA to discuss next steps.

2. **E-bikes:** AVCA reported decrease in complaints but anticipates an increase while school is out for the summer.
