Public Comments:

1. Tom Merritt commented on the Avalon Bay housing development.

New Business

1. Orange County Sherriff's Department (OCSD) Presence at AVCA 4th of July Event

Discussion: AVCA has requested the same number of deputies, sergeant and hours as last year. AVCA agreed to those terms for reimbursement of OCSD costs during the event, and the agreement amendment was signed. AVCA anticipates a higher turnout this year.

Action: None

2. Landscape Product Usage in the Community

Discussion: AVCA has listened to residents' concerns and has been directed by their

board of directors to cease the use of synthetic products on park turf.

Action: AVCA is working with their landscape vendor to formulate a plan.

3. Recreation Programs Partnership

Discussion: The City has requested to use certain AVCA parks for city recreation programs. AVCA is supportive and working with their board of directors to finalize the agreement.

Action: AVCA Board of Directors is reviewing the request and will work with the City to discuss next steps.

4. Stormwater Project

Discussion: Director of Public Works Shaun Pelletier provided an overview of new State regulations for treating rainwater flow and ways that the City plans to fulfill the requirements.

Action: City will work with partners within the region to fulfill requirements.

5. AVCA Capital Projects

Discussion: AVCA plans to install solar-powered lighting in the Ridgecrest Park parking lot, a permanent restroom facility at Aliso Canyon Community Park, resurface several private streets, upgrade lighting at Woodfield Park to LED and adding benches and a canopy at Aliso Viejo Community Park.

Action: Projects are subject to approval from the Board of Directors. AVCA will provide an update to the City.

6. General Common Issues and Interagency Communication

Discussion: Acting City Manager Mitzi Ortiz expressed her appreciation to AVCA for their collaboration. Mayor Pro Tem Ackley asked about the possibility of lowering the City's landscape costs by utilizing AVCA's contractors. Director of Public Works Shaun Pelletier and AVCA board members explained why this would not be possible.
