CALL TO ORDER

The special meeting of the Irvine City Council was called to order at 2:32 p.m. on October 13, 2020, in the City Council Chamber, Irvine Civic Center, One Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, California; Mayor Shea presiding.

RECONVENE TO THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING


