A regular meeting of the Irvine City Council was called to order at 4:06 p.m. on August 9, 2011 in the City Council Chamber, Irvine Civic Center, One Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, California; Mayor Kang presiding.

Mayor Kang requested a moment of silence in honor of Homer Guimond, Chair of the Senior Citizens Council, who passed away on July 31, 2011; American forces in Afghanistan with the loss last week of the transport helicopter carrying the Navy Seals; and San Diego Police Officer Jeremy Henwood, who was fatally shot while on duty.

1. PUBLIC HEARINGS

1.1 ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 11-24 (PLANNING AREA 40) AND ASSOCIATED ACQUISITION OF IMPROVEMENTS AND ASSESSMENTS

2. COUNCIL BUSINESS

2.1 ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES COMPLYING WITH PROVISIONS OF ASSEMBLY BILL X1 27 ("ABX1 27"), ELECTING TO IMPLEMENT PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY OF IRVINE AND IRVINE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN THE ALTERNATIVE VOLUNTARY REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZATION TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE REGARDING THE OPT-IN ALLOCATION

City Manager Joyce introduced Mark Asturias, Manager of Housing and Redevelopment, and Bill Ihrke, Legal Counsel, who provided the staff report.

There was no City Council discussion.

ACTION: Moved by Mayor Kang, seconded by Councilmember Lalloway, and unanimously carried to:

- 1) Read by title only and adoption of URGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 11-10 - AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING IT WILL COMPLY WITH THE VOLUNTARY ALTERNATIVE REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO PART 1.9 OF DIVISION 24 OF THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE TO PERMIT THE CONTINUED EXISTENCE AND OPERATION OF THE IRVINE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
- 2) Introduce for first reading and read by title only ORDINANCE NO. 11-11 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING IT WILL COMPLY WITH THE VOLUNTARY ALTERNATIVE REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO PART 1.9 OF DIVISION 24 OF THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE TO PERMIT THE CONTINUED EXISTENCE AND OPERATION OF THE IRVINE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
- 3) File an appeal with the California Department of Finance in response to its Alternative Voluntary Redevelopment Program allocation.

2.2 CITY OF IRVINE RECOGNITION OF DAVID G. SILLS

This item was agendized at the request of Councilmember Lalloway, who recommended the renaming of Northwood Community Center or another City facility/amenity in honor of former City of Irvine Mayor and Councilmember David G. Sills.

City Council discussion included: whether the request is consistent with the City's procedures for naming city facilities in recognition of individuals (City Council Resolution No. 07-24) and examples of such facilities/amenities; project timeline for the rehabilitation for the Northwood Park Community Center and additional features incorporated into its design; and potential community concerns.

ACTION: Moved by Councilmember Lalloway, seconded by Councilmember Choi, and unanimously carried to:

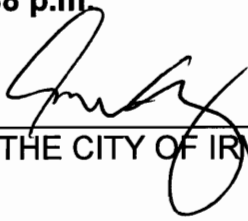

PUBLIC COMMENTS

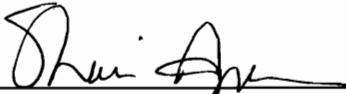
Erica Johnson, Director of Community Relations from Sullivan Solar Power, spoke in support of expanding solar power outreach efforts and encouraged City support of such efforts.
