SEARCH THE FEED

“What” field

Flock Safety Cameras, not only captures license plates, but also identifies a vehicle’s make, color, and build. **What** determines the types of images that will be returned in your search. You may select certain vehicle attributes (e.g., build, make, and color) or specific license plate information (e.g., tag number, tag type, and state).

“Where” field

We have ten (10) fixed cameras in reactive areas to assist during an investigation. **Where** determines which cameras will be searched. All of the cameras in your network will be selected by default. To focus on a specific area, click on the camera names to remove them from the search. They will turn from green to grey.

“When” field

This is self-explanatory, but it offers the option to “+ Add Time Window.” If you are looking for a vehicle that you know passes a camera during lunch hour, you are able to run one search across multiple days.

VIEWING THE RESULTS

ACCESS TO THE HOTLIST TOOL

All users assigned to the role will have access to Hot List in their nav bar and be able to log in to the tool. Users are able to receive browser, SMS (Department issued PCD), and email notifications for hits coming from NCIC, state databases, or custom lists by an investigator or supervisor.

SEARCH REASON

Every search requires a reason. This should be the case number affiliated with the search. If there is a time when a case number is not available, please briefly explain the reason for the search.

AUDITING

Audits will be performed on a regular basis.
