Regarding tree trimming, it should be a fairly mild trim as we need to make sure the lens has a clear shot, since the camera field of views are fairly narrow. I would say 12-18" should be all that's need for the camera/solar panel to be made room for, as the camera/solar panel will likely be mounted right above where the no parking sign is.

Since these revisions work, I will let our operations team know. Do you need anything additional from us regarding permitting or engineering details?

I hope you are all staying healthy and things are going as well as can be expected during this time!

I wanted to follow up with notes from the site survey that we recently performed with notes from the tech (photos included for the alternate location for #3/4 and #9/10):

- Location 3 and 4 - existing pole is crowded. Alternate location (existing pole) is 200' North of proposed location.
- Location 7 and 8 - existing pole is crowded but there are no alternate street light poles nearby that will work, because of no solar, due to tree blockage.
- Location 9 and 10 - existing pole is crowded. Alternate location (existing pole) 250' West of the intersection, with a tree, but with minimal trimming it will work.

Do you know if we could find a power source for #7/8? or possibly another location that you had in

mind? Let me know if you have any questions, or need any additional information from us, such as engineering drawings, or technical specifications.
