SUBJECT: Flock Activity Report for June 2023

R/C is submitting the following information to document the number of Flock Hit notifications that resulted in field contacts with vehicles for the month of June 2023. The information is compiled on a monthly basis and indicates the specific vehicles, the reason for the individual stops and the demographics of the subjects involved.

R/C has enclosed the attached pages that document contacts. In the month of June 2023, there were four (4) Flock contacts or attempts to contact the driver. Of those four contacts, one resulted in an arrest by the Berwyn Police Department. Two (2) of the stops involved discrepancies with the registration plates not having the LEADS Hit of a stolen motor vehicle removed and the last Flock hit involved a reckless driver with the description of a passenger being obtained, because he was hanging out of the vehicle.
