I want to clarify that the basic CONNECT functions are included, and the three months that comes with the basic solution is specifically for callers to do proactive outreach. As we discussed you can spread this out across the contract and when you upgrade to Enterprise Plus additional time is added to the contract.

If you wanted to buy additional time for someone to do the outreach calling, it is \$5,000 per month per caller.
